The Loan Facility has a maturity date of the earlier of completion of the transaction for the sale of the Company's interest in Woodlark Mining Limited with repayment to be determined as outlined in the Terms Sheet dated 6 March 2019 (announced on the ASX on 8 March 2019), seven days after either party giving written notice that the transaction as contemplated by the Terms Sheet will not be proceeding and 30 June 2019.
